## **Challenges**

Access to Skilled Staff: My biggest challenge with Pachi Travel is having access to skilled staff, which is linked to finding fair funding opportunities to integrate more people to work with me. I can learn new skills but it takes long time working isolated instead developing the parts of my business in which I am good. Most of it is because I don't have the income to only work on my business.

Network: Coming from underrepresented background makes it difficult to rely on a wide network that we usually get to meet when our families and ourselves spend time living in the same country.
